WHEN YOU ARRIVE...

Students should go to assigned dressing areas. Volunteer mothers will be with them at this location. Volunteers still needed see back of this Newsletter!!!

Following the first number's rehearsal on stage, the volunteers will escort the classes back to the assigned dressing areas. Dancers are dismissed if they have no other classes.

Most younger students will be gathered in a room adjacent to stage right. This will allow the easiest path for them to and from the stage.
