As I mentioned in the last newsletter, picture "week" at READ Photography (1800 42nd Street) has been scheduled for May 2 through 6 and May 14. (See the back side of this newsletter for schedule.)

The deadlines have passed for recital music tapes/CDs and certificates honoring more than 5 years of dance. It is not too late, however, for volunteers to sign up to help at dress rehearsal and the evenings of the show. (See back of this Newsletter) There is also still time for any fathers to join our father/daughter dance team. Rehearsals are Monday evenings at Regis Middle School from 8:30-9:00 for those that have danced less than 8 years and 9:15-9:45 for my more experienced dancers.

Finally, recital fees is due this month (APRIL) \$48 first child, \$24 second child. Please mail or drop off at the STUDIO. All balances must be paid (costume and shoe balances) before recital.

Students should go to assigned dressing areas. Volunteer mothers will be with them at this location. **Volunteers still needed see back of this Newsletter!!!**

Following the first number's rehearsal on stage, the volunteers will escort the classes back to the assigned dressing areas. Dancers are dismissed if they have no other classes.

Most younger students will be gathered in a room adjacent to stage right. This will allow the easiest path for them to and from the stage.
